Updated recommendations include:

- Revised: gender specific language to “all patients” to make inclusive

Assess

- Added: Assess “all patients” – deleted “males and females”
- Added: additional resources
- Added: link to the current Michigan laws on mandated reporting
- Changed: supportive adult to “trusted” adult in sentence on “Encourage every patient...”

Interventions

- Updated: contraceptive methods and treatment to include “EPT; Expedited Partner Therapy”
